READ IT AND RATE IT: READING PROGRAM

Students are encouraged to participate in the Read It and Rate It: Reading Program. The upper school student and lower school student reading the most books will receive a gift card reward to a local store.

Books read between November 1st and December 7th may be used for this program. Students need to read books that are age appropriate and on their reading level. When in doubt, ask Mrs. Hoppock. Once students finish their books, they are asked to do the following:

1. See the Librarian
2. Pick an apple or a leaf
3. Write the title on the apple or leaf
4. Rate the book

- 1 star: Horrible
- 2 stars: I made it through
- 3 stars: OKAY
- 4 stars: REALLY GOOD
- 5 stars: GREAT/I'll read it again
