## Admission Application

### Glenforest School Admissions Process

Admission to Glenforest School is contingent upon acceptance by the Glenforest School Admissions Team. The following is the process for admission:

1. The parent/guardian(s) will meet with the Head of School or Designee.
2. The parent/guardian(s) will complete an application and submit to the school.
3. After review, if the team feels the student will benefit from Glenforest School, the student will visit a classroom for a portion of the school day. During the visit, the student will be interviewed. If application occurs during the summer, the student will only complete the interview.
4. The Admission Team will review all information and the parent will be notified of their decision.
5. If accepted, the Chief Financial Officer will contact the parent to arrange for tuition payment.

### The following items are required to initiate the official Glenforest School admission process:

*(Please submit documents, and related enclosures, to Glenforest School by mail, email, or in person)*

- Educational diagnostic testing records, completed by psychologist (not more than 2 years old)
- Request for Official School Records
- Information, testing dates and results relating to any previous special academic or medical placement, including any psychological testing and additional educational diagnostic testing.
